Dear "Baires, Blanca" <BlancaBaires@dpss.lacounty.gov>:

I am once again very disturbed about the pending action to be taken against my case with DPSS.

On Sunday, November 23, 2014 we picked up the mail at our post office box. We discovered that there were three letters from DPSS.

The letter with the postmark of November 17, 2014 was the notice of action to apparently cancel our food stamps because DPSS has not received an SAR 7 form. I am disturbed because it was my understanding that there were no further reporting requirements past the annual renewal that we went through in May 2014. I have not come across any document that stated that I needed to return and fill out an SAR 7 form.

The letter with the postmark of November 21, 2014 was the notice of action to apparently cancel our Health Care benefits. To say it in the most positive way this way I possibly can the wording on the letter absolutely positively made no sense whatsoever.

And since I was unsuccessful in a previous attempt to call to request a state hearing I am going the route of making this request and demand by EMAIL. I have discussed at length this issue with LAFRANCE TOLIVER at great length. Bottom line the phone number that you have on your letters to request a state hearing is a meaningless trash phone number.

It is my request and my expectation that someone on this distribution list confirm the receipt of this email as well as confirm they have put a stop on all pending actions Robert Colaco's case effective at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, November 26, 2014.

As far as the issue of being available for someone to call me. I can be available from 4 to 7 pm on most days. However, I need to receive a voicemail message the day before to let me know that someone will call. Please call (818)574-8911.

Thank you in advance for all of your efforts to accomodate my request and demand.
